The Outreach Committee. The Food Shelf is always in need of food items. There is a cart in the Narthex for donations.

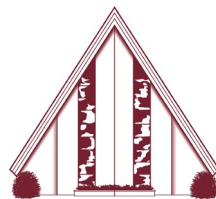
