Dear 1st Lutheran Family: While many of you know Ethan and his medical condition, some of you don't. Ethan was diagnosed at 1 year of age with Generalized Seizures. In October 2010 he was diagnosed with Glut1 Deficiency Syndrome. Glut 1 DS is where the brain is not getting the necessary glucose because the protein transporters do not work correctly. This deficiency causes seizures, learning difficulties, low muscle tone, balance control, and other issues. Randy, Brittani, and Lacy have all been diagnosed with the same genetic mutation, but do not suffer the effects that Ethan does.

We have joined the Glut1 Deficiency Foundation (a rare disease of a little than 500 people worldwide) in a fundraising effort to help fund upcoming studies and better yet, a possible cure. If successful they may provide an option for Ethan and many other children besides the ketogenic diet which is a very strict, high-fat, low-carb diet. 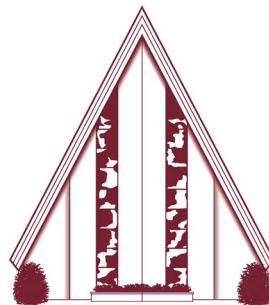
