Part-time- .25 FTE

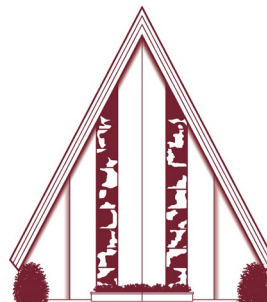
