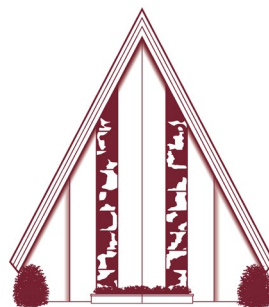
75th Anniversary! Sunday, June 15th, during and after worship – A celebration of the 75th Anniversary of Henry Aukee's Ordination.
