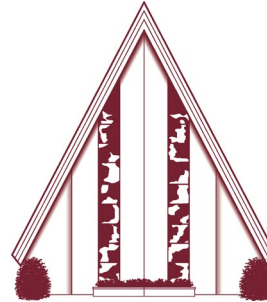
**Camp Wapo!** We will have children and teens at Camp Wapo June 20 – 27. Please keep the campers, the camp staff, and the chaperones in your prayers.
