**Candles for Epiphany** can be brought at any time. Epiphany begins this January 10/11. Candles should be white and unscented. Any size and shape welcome.

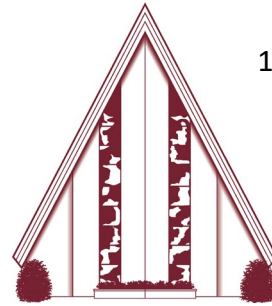
